- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Title 4, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Chapter 95A to read as follows:
- 7 CHAPTER 95A. LIMITED LIABILITY FOR BUSINESS THAT ALLOWS HANDGUNS
- 8 Sec. 95A.001. LIMITED LIABILITY FOR BUSINESS THAT ALLOWS
- 9 HANDGUNS. The owner or operator of a business on the premises of
- 10 which the carrying of a handgun is not otherwise unlawful is immune
- 11 from civil liability with respect to any claim that is based on the
- 12 owner's or operator's failure to exercise the option to forbid the
- 13 carrying of handguns on the premises by customers or employees.
- 14 SECTION 2. Chapter 95A, Civil Practice and Remedies Code,
- 15 as added by this Act, does not apply to a cause of action that
- 16 accrued before the effective date of this Act. A cause of action
- 17 that accrued before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 18 the law applicable to the cause of action immediately before that
- 19 date, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
