## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to civil liability of a local government for failure to
- 3 comply with an immigration detainer.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 101, Civil Practice and
- 6 Remedies Code, is amended by adding Section 101.0216 to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 Sec. 101.0216. LIABILITY OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT FOR FAILURE TO
- 9 COMPLY WITH IMMIGRATION DETAINER. (a) In this section, "local
- 10 government" means a county, municipality, or political subdivision
- 11 of this state.
- 12 (b) A local government that releases from custody a person
- 13 who is the subject of an immigration detainer issued by United
- 14 States Immigration and Customs Enforcement is liable for damages
- 15 resulting from a felony committed by the person in this state within
- 16 four years following the person's release.
- 17 <u>(c)</u> This section does not create liability for damages
- 18 sustained by a person who is subject to an immigration detainer
- 19 <u>following the person's release by a local government.</u>
- 20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 21 with respect to the release of a person from custody on or after the
- 22 effective date of this Act.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
