- 5 SECTION 1. Section 30.021, Civil Practice and Remedies
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 30.021. AWARD OF ATTORNEY'S FEES IN RELATION TO
- 8 CERTAIN MOTIONS TO DISMISS. In a civil proceeding, on a trial
- 9 court's granting or denial, in whole or in part, of a motion to
- 10 dismiss filed under the rules adopted by the supreme court under
- 11 Section 22.004(g), Government Code, the court may [shall] award
- 12 costs and reasonable and necessary attorney's fees to the
- 13 prevailing party. This section does not apply to actions by or
- 14 against the state, other governmental entities, or public officials
- 15 acting in their official capacity or under color of law.
- SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 17 a civil action commenced on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 18 A civil action commenced before the effective date of this Act is
- 19 governed by the law applicable to the action immediately before the
- 20 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
- 21 that purpose.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
