- 11 (b) In an open-enrollment charter school that serves youth
- 12 referred to or placed in a residential trade center by a local or
- 13 state agency, a person may be employed as a teacher for a noncore
- 14 vocational course without holding a baccalaureate degree if the

- 16 (1) demonstrated subject matter expertise related to
- 17 the subject taught, such as professional work experience, formal

- 19 industry license, certification, or registration, or any

- 22 (2) received at least 20 hours of classroom management
