5	SECTION 1. Section 545.062, Transportation Code, is amended
6	by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
7	(d) An operator of a vehicle equipped with a connected
8	braking system that is following another vehicle equipped with that
9	system may be assisted by the system to maintain an assured clear
10	distance or sufficient space as required by this section. In this
11	subsection, "connected braking system" means a system by which the
12	braking of one vehicle is electronically coordinated with the
13	braking system of a following vehicle.
14	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
15	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
16	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
17	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
18	Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
