3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 81, Government Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 81.116 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 81.116. FIRM NAMES. (a) An attorney may not use a firm
7	name, letterhead, or other professional designation that is false,
8	misleading, or deceptive.
9	(b) An attorney may practice under a trade name that:
10	(1) does not imply a connection with a government
11	agency or with a public or charitable legal services organization;
12	(2) does not imply the firm is something other than a
13	private law firm; and
14	(3) is not false, misleading, or deceptive.
15	(c) The supreme court may not adopt rules that conflict with
16	this section.
17	SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
18	of this Act, the Texas Supreme Court shall modify its rules as
19	necessary to comply with Section 81.116, Government Code, as added
20	by this Act.
21	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
