H.B. No. 4233

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the regulation of package store permit holders.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 22.06, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
5 amended to read as follows:

6 Sec. 22.06. PROHIBITED INTERESTS. (a) Except as otherwise
7 provided in Section [102.05](#) of this code and in Subsection (b) of
8 this section, no person who holds a package store permit or owns an
9 interest in a package store may have a direct or indirect interest
10 in any of the following:

11 (1) a manufacturer's, retail dealer's on-premise, or
12 general, branch, or local distributor's license;

13 (2) a wine and beer retailer's[, wine and beer
14 ~~retailer's off-premise~~] or mixed beverage permit: or

17 (b) A package store permit and a retail dealer's off-premise
18 license or a wine and beer retailer's off-premise permit may be
19 issued to the same person.

20 SECTION 2. Section 22.14(d), Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
21 amended to read as follows:

22 (d) Subsections (a) and [~~–~~] (b)[~~–~~ and ~~(c)~~] shall not apply
23 to a package store that qualifies for exemption under Section 11.50
24 or to a package store in a hotel that qualifies for exemption under

1 Section 102.05.

2 SECTION 3. Sections 22.04, 22.05, 22.14(c), and 22.16,
3 Alcoholic Beverage Code, are repealed.

4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
