- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 772, Government Code, is
- amended by adding Section 772.0073 to read as follows: 6
- Sec. 772.0073. BULLETPROOF VEST GRANT PROGRAM. (a) In this 7
- section, "criminal justice division" means the criminal justice 8
- 9 division established under Section 772.006.
- (b) The criminal justice division shall establish and 10
- administer a grant program to provide financial assistance to a law 11
- 12 enforcement agency seeking to equip its peace officers with
- bulletproof vests. Any law enforcement agency in this state may 13
- 14 apply for a grant under this section.
- 15 (c) An agency receiving a grant under this section must, as
- 16 soon as practicable after receiving the grant, provide to the
- criminal justice division proof of purchase of bulletproof vests, 17
- including the price of each vest and the number of vests purchased. 18
- (d) Not later than December 1 of each year, the criminal 19
- justice division shall submit a report to the Legislative Budget 20
- Board reporting the following information for the preceding state 21
- 22 fiscal year:

- 23 (1) the name of each agency that applied for a grant
- 24 under this section;

- 1 (2) the amount of money distributed to each agency
- 2 that received a grant under this section; and
- 3 (3) the number of vests purchased by each agency
- 4 <u>described by Subdivision (2).</u>
- 5 <u>(e) The criminal justice division may use any revenue</u>
- 6 available for purposes of this section.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
