- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Title 4, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Chapter 71A to read as follows:

6 CHAPTER 71A. PROHIBITED CAUSES OF ACTION

- 7 Sec. 71A.001. WRONGFUL BIRTH. A cause of action may not
- 8 arise, and damages may not be awarded, on behalf of any person,
- 9 based on the claim that but for the act or omission of another, a
- 10 person would not have been permitted to have been born alive but
- 11 would have been aborted.
- 12 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 13 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
- 14 this Act. A cause of action that accrues before the effective date
- 15 of this Act is governed by the law applicable to the cause of action
- 16 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 17 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
