

SENATE BILLS RETURNED FROM HOUSE WITH AMENDMENTS

SJR 2 **Birdwell/ Bettencourt/ Campbell/ Creighton/ Hancock/ et al.** **SP: Miller/ et al.**

Applying to the Congress of the United States to call a convention under Article V of the United States Constitution for the limited purpose of proposing one or more amendments to the constitution to impose fiscal restraints on the federal government, to limit the power and jurisdiction of the federal government, and to limit the terms of office of federal officials and members of Congress.

SJR 38 **Estes/ et al.** **SP: Darby**

Rescinding certain applications made by the Texas Legislature to the United States Congress to call a national convention under Article V of the United States Constitution for proposing any amendment to that Constitution.

SB 16 **Nichols/ Huffman/ et al.** **SP: King, Phil/ et al.**

Relating to decreasing the fee for the issuance of an original or renewed license to carry a handgun.

SB 21 **Birdwell/ Bettencourt/ Campbell/ Creighton/ Hancock/ et al.** **SP: King, Phil/ et al.**

Relating to the qualifications, duties, and limitations of Texas delegates to a convention called under Article V of the United States Constitution.

SB 301 **Watson/ Hinojosa/ Taylor, Van** **SP: Flynn**

Relating to the operations and functions of the Employees Retirement System of Texas and the sunset review date for, financial management of, and programs administered by the agency.

SB 507 **Hancock/ et al.** **SP: Frullo/ et al.**

Relating to mediation of the settlement of certain out-of-network health benefit claims involving balance billing.

SB 1070 **Hancock** **SP: Frullo**

Relating to authorized reinsurance and financial statement credit and accounting for reinsurance.
