SB 504 **Taylor, Van/ et al.**
Relating to lobbying by former members of the legislature; creating an offense.

Relating to restrictions on lobbyist expenditures from certain political contributions.

The Senate adopted the following resolutions:

Granting the legislature permission to adjourn for more than three days during the period beginning on Wednesday, February 15, 2017, and ending on Tuesday, February 21, 2017.
