Relating to reporting requirements by health care practitioners and certain health care facilities for abortion complications and to an annual report by the Department of State Health Services; providing a civil penalty.

Perry

Relating to the provision of pharmacy services through a telepharmacy system; establishing a remote dispensing site license.

SB 1758 Zaffirini

Relating to requirements for the court in permanency hearings for children in the conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services who are receiving transitional living services.

SB 1927 Kolkhorst

Relating to requiring the Health and Human Services Commission to evaluate and implement changes to the Medicaid program to make the program more cost-effective, increase competition among providers, and improve health outcomes for recipients.

SB 1929 Kolkhorst

Relating to a report on maternal mortality and the continuation of the Maternal Mortality and Morbidity Task Force.
