IN RE: SB438 by Hegar (Relating to prohibiting immunization against human papilloma virus as a condition for admission to public school.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would prohibit requiring immunization against human papilloma virus (HPV) as a condition for admission to any elementary or secondary school. All contrary executive orders of the governor would be preempted by the bill.
