1	Amend C.S.H.B. No. 3153 (House committee printing) by
2	adding the following appropriately numbered SECTION to Article 1
3	of the bill and renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of the bill
4	accordingly:
5	SECTION (a) Subchapter B, Chapter 43, Government
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 43.1321 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 43.1321. JURISDICTION OF TRAVIS COUNTY DISTRICT
8	ATTORNEY. (a) The portion of the Travis County District
9	Attorney, the District Attorney for the 53rd Judicial District,
10	that relates to the investigation or prosecution of crimes
11	related to public integrity, including the operation of any
12	public integrity unit, is transferred to the office of the
13	attorney general if a person serving as district attorney for
14	the 53rd Judicial District is convicted of a criminal offense
15	other than a Class C misdemeanor while in office, including an
16	offense under Chapter 49, Penal Code, involving the operation of
17	a motor vehicle while intoxicated.
18	(b) Jurisdiction over the investigation or prosecution of
19	crimes, including the operation of any public integrity unit is
20	returned to the Travis County District Attorney, the District
21	Attorney for the 53rd Judicial District, when the person
22	described by Subsection (a) leaves office.
23	(b) Section 43.1321, Government Code, as added by this
24	Act, applies to a person serving as district attorney for the
25	53rd Judicial District on or after the effective date of this
26	Act.
27	(c) Notwithstanding the effective date of this Act, this
28	section takes effect immediately if this Act receives a vote of

two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided

by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act

- 1 does not receive the vote necessary for this section to have
- 2 immediate effect, this section takes effect September 1, 2013.
