- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 25.0811(a), Education Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (a) Except as provided by this section, a school district
- 7 may not begin instruction for students for a school year before the
- 8 <u>second</u> [fourth] Monday in August. A school district may:
- 9 (1) begin instruction for students for a school year
- 10 before the second [fourth] Monday in August if the district
- 11 operates a year-round system under Section 25.084; or
- 12 (2) begin instruction for students for a school year
- 13 on or after the first Monday in August at a campus or at not more
- 14 than 20 percent of the campuses in the district if:
- 15 (A) the district has a student enrollment of
- 16 190,000 or more;
- 17 (B) the district at the beginning of the school
- 18 year provides, financed with local funds, days of instruction for
- 19 students at the campus or at each of the multiple campuses, in
- 20 addition to the minimum [number of days of] instruction time
- 21 required under Section 25.081;
- (C) the campus or each of the multiple campuses

- 1 (D) a majority of the students at the campus or at
- 2 each of the multiple campuses are educationally disadvantaged.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
- 4 school year.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
