HB 1177 Murr | et al. SP: Buckingham
Relating to the release on personal bond of a person arrested for an out-of-county offense under certain circumstances.

HB 1178 Kuempel | et al. SP: Hinojosa
Relating to the punishment for burglary and theft of controlled substances.

HB 1257 Kacal SP: Birdwell
Relating to the prosecution of and punishment for the offense of criminal mischief involving property used for flood control purposes or a dam.

HB 1264 Burkett | et al. SP: Huffines
Relating to the concurrent jurisdiction of certain municipal courts in certain criminal cases punishable by fine only.
