Relating to the elimination of school district maintenance and operations ad valorem taxes and the creation of a joint interim committee on the elimination of those taxes.

HB 1662 Herrero  
Relating to grants awarded to reimburse counties for the cost of monitoring defendants and victims in criminal cases involving family violence.

HB 3266 Raney  
Relating to fees charged to students enrolled at component institutions of The Texas A&M University System.

HB 3303 Bowers  
Relating to certain procedures involving a violation of a condition of community supervision committed by a defendant who is the sole caretaker of a child.

Relating to prescribing and dispensing controlled substances and monitoring the prescribing and dispensing of controlled substances under the Texas Controlled Substances Act; providing for administrative penalties.
