HB 3303 Bowers Relating to the revocation of community supervision for a violation of a condition of community supervision committed by a defendant who is the primary caretaker of a child or is pregnant.

HB 3472 Bailes Relating to a rodeo hosted by the Texas Department of Criminal Justice; authorizing a fee.

HB 3512 Pacheco Relating to community supervision.

HB 3529 Gutierrez Relating to a domestic violence pilot program.

HB 3620 Reynolds Relating to the creation of a mental health treatment for incarceration diversion pilot program.

HB 3978 Gutierrez Relating to a defendant making a specified donation in lieu of working a specified number of hours at a community service project.

HB 4009 Toth Relating to the establishment, operation, and funding of victim-offender mediation programs; authorizing fees.

HB 4104 White Relating to the sentencing procedures and punishment for the offense of prostitution and to programs for certain defendants charged with or convicted of prostitution.

HB 4594 González, Jessica Relating to the punishment for certain possession offenses under the Texas Controlled Substances Act; changing eligibility for and conditions of community supervision.
