HB 4013 Miller Relating to sales and use taxes on e-cigarette vapor products; imposing taxes; providing an administrative penalty.

HB 4621 Huberty Relating to the imposition of sales and use taxes and the allocation of certain revenue from sales and use taxes to school district property tax relief and public education; authorizing the imposition of a tax.

HJR 3 Huberty Proposing a constitutional amendment to provide funding for the cost of maintaining and operating the public school system and to reduce school district ad valorem tax rates through an increase in the state sales and use tax rate.
