Relating to indicators of achievement under the public school accountability system.

Relating to the continuation and functions of the School Land Board.

Relating to prohibiting the use of certain behavioral interventions on students enrolled in public school who receive special education services.

SB 1412 Perry

Relating to the creation of accelerated campus excellence turnaround plans for low-performing schools.

Relating to the acquisition and management of certain real property assets by the School Land Board for the use and benefit of the permanent school fund and the transfer of certain permanent school fund assets from the control of the School Land Board to the State Board of Education.

SB 1895 Taylor

Relating to grants for school districts and campuses providing blended and individualized learning staff development activities.

SB 1776 Campbell

Relating to the inclusion of an elective course on the founding principles of the United States in the curriculum for public high school students and the posting of the founding documents of the United States in public school buildings.

SB 1777 Campbell

Relating to the United States history end-of-course assessment instrument for public high school students.

SB 2042 Fallon

Relating to a study by the Texas Education Agency of career and technology education programs.

SB 2107 Lucio

Relating to evaluating the performance of dropout recovery schools for purposes of the public school accountability system.

SB 2440 Taylor

Relating to the Texas school finance system, including the creation of the bicentennial education fund, the establishment of the Texas Education Investment Management Organization, and the management and investment of the permanent school fund.

SJR 78 Taylor

Proposing a constitutional amendment relating to the permanent school fund.
