## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to prohibited local regulations regarding certain
- 3 late-night and overnight deliveries to food service
- 4 establishments.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 437, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 7 by adding Section 437.029 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 437.029. PROHIBITED LOCAL REGULATIONS RELATING TO
- 9 CERTAIN LATE-NIGHT AND OVERNIGHT DELIVERIES TO FOOD SERVICE
- 10 ESTABLISHMENTS. Notwithstanding any other law, the department, a
- 11 county, a municipality, or a public health district may not require
- 12 <u>a food service establishment to obtain a sound regulation permit,</u>
- 13 charge a sound regulation fee to an establishment, or otherwise
- 14 prohibit sound-related activity at an establishment for sound
- 15 arising from the delivery of food, nonalcoholic beverages, food
- 16 service supplies, or ice to the establishment if the establishment
- 17 accepts delivery of those items for one hour or less between 10 p.m.
- 18 and 5 a.m., provided the sound level from the deliveries does not
- 19 exceed 75 dBA when measured from the residential property closest
- 20 in proximity to the establishment, excluding traffic and other
- 21 background noise that can be reasonably excluded.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
