- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 1-s to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 1-s. (a) The legislature by general law may exempt
- 9 from ad valorem taxation tangible personal property consisting of
- 10 <u>animal feed held by the owner of the property for sale at retail.</u>
- 11 (b) The legislature by general law may provide additional
- 12 eligibility requirements for the exemption authorized by this
- 13 <u>section</u>.
- 14 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 15 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 4, 2025.
- 16 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 17 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 18 legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation tangible personal
- 19 property consisting of animal feed held by the owner of the property
- 20 for sale at retail."
