Proposing a constitutional amendment to clarify and implement certain provisions governing the impeachment, trial, removal from office, and disqualification of public officers.

SB 217 West/ et al.

Relating to establishing the Historic Texas Freedmen's Cemetery Designation Program; authorizing a fee.

SB 331 (CS) (LC) Kolkhorst

Relating to the disclosure of health care cost information by certain health care facilities; imposing an administrative penalty.

SB 530 Sparks

Relating to the accreditation of certain postsecondary educational institutions in this state or of certain programs offered by those institutions.

SB 546 (CS) Menéndez/ et al.

Relating to seat belts on buses that transport children.

Relating to establishing the Historic Texas Cemeteries Designation Program; authorizing a fee.

SB 1150 (CS) Middleton/ et al.

Relating to the plugging of and reporting on inactive wells subject to the jurisdiction of the Railroad Commission of Texas; authorizing an administrative penalty.

Relating to digital replication rights in the voice and visual likeness of individuals; providing private causes of action; authorizing a fee.

SB 2051 (CS) (LC)**Birdwell/ et al.**

Relating to the impeachment or removal from office of certain public officers, including procedures governing the impeachment, trial on impeachment, and disqualification of state officers, and to the grounds for which certain public officers may be removed from office.

Relating to the operation of vehicles at railroad grade crossings; increasing a criminal penalty.

Relating to the periods during which a retail fireworks permit holder may sell fireworks to the public.

Relating to the bilingual education allotment under the public school finance system.
