The Senate suspended the necessary rules to consider and finally pass:

SB 1498 (LC) Nichols/ et al.
Relating to civil asset forfeiture of digital currency or other similar property.

The Senate suspended the regular order, read third time and finally passed:

SB 8 (CS) Schwertner/ Huffman/ et al.
Relating to agreements between sheriffs and the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement to enforce federal immigration law.

**SB 16 (CS) Hughes/ Bettencourt/ Birdwell/
Campbell/ Creighton/ et al.**
Relating to requiring a person to submit proof of citizenship to register to vote; creating criminal offenses.

SB 318 Creighton/ et al.
Relating to the establishment of the election integrity division in the office of the attorney general.

SB 371 (LC) Campbell/ et al.
Relating to parental approval for a student's participation in human sexuality instruction in public schools.

SB 396 Kolkhorst/ Bettencourt/ et al.
Relating to confirmation of a voter's residence by a voter registrar.

SB 533 Sparks
Relating to the election date for the authorization of the issuance of bonds or a tax increase.

SB 707 King/ et al.
Relating to the authority of the legislature to determine that certain federal directives are unconstitutional and to prohibit certain government officers and employees from enforcing or assisting in the enforcement of the directive.

SB 875 Birdwell/ et al.
Relating to prohibiting election activities committed by a member of the board of trustees or superintendent of an independent school district or on certain school district premises; creating criminal offenses.

**SB 965 (LC) Parker/ Bettencourt/ Campbell/
Creighton/ Hall/ et al.**
Relating to the right of a public school employee to engage in religious speech or prayer while on duty.
