Relating to the unauthorized entry, occupancy, sale, rental, lease,  
advertisement for sale, rental, or lease, or conveyance of real property,  
including the removal of certain unauthorized occupants of a dwelling;  
creating criminal offenses; increasing a criminal penalty; authorizing a  
fee.
