Relating to the confidentiality of certain information for a current or former administrative law judge for the State Office of Administrative Hearings.

Relating to prohibiting the imposition of a monetary fine or penalty for a violation of a money services business's terms of service agreement; providing a civil penalty.

SB 647 West
Relating to the filing or recording of documents or instruments conveying or purporting to convey an interest in real or personal property.

Relating to recording requirements for certain instruments concerning real property.

Relating to the establishment of an Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment Advisory Board.

Relating to the regulation of certain business entities that act as data brokers.

Relating to the authority of the advisory body of a public improvement district and the board of directors of a reinvestment zone to hold a meeting by a telecommunication device.

Relating to the regulation of delivery network companies; requiring an occupational permit; authorizing a fee.

Relating to the licensing and regulation of massage therapy.

SB 2184 Hinojosa, Adam
Relating to the required age for a license or permit relating to the conduct of a public fireworks display.

SB 2211 Sparks
Relating to a qualifying cogenerator that serves a large load and a colocated desalination facility.

SB 2268 Schwertner
Relating to disbursement of initial funds under the Texas Energy Fund.

SB 2349 Alvarado
Relating to notice requirements for a leased dwelling located in a floodplain.

SB 2443 Zaffirini
Relating to electronic delivery of documents sent or received by the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation.

SB 2629 Creighton
Relating to organization of, meetings of, and voting by condominium unit owners' associations and property owners' associations.

SB 2702 Creighton
Relating to the licensing and regulation of persons who may repair or test backflow prevention assemblies.

SB 2902 Zaffirini
Relating to the collection of consumer debt incurred by certain individuals as a result of identity theft.
